Bowman studied abroad in Taiwan through UGA's Department of Public Health and participated in its Medical Scholars Program. During his UGA tenure, he worked in the school's biomechanics lab where he researched and gave presentations on chronic ankle instability. Bowman also volunteered as a clinic coordinator at Augusta's free 8th Street Clinic.

Bowman's expertise includes caring for a variety of orthopaedic conditions with a special focus on foot and ankle care, including sports-related injuries and forefoot problems such as bunions, hammertoes and Morton's neuroma. He also provides fracture care and treatment of foot and ankle deformities. He chose orthopaedics because it allows him to help patients enjoy a better quality of life. Bowman makes sure his patients receive a thorough explanation of their condition and treatment options, and have answers to all of their questions by the time they leave his office.

Bowman fell in love with Brunswick and the Golden Isles during his medical school clinical rotation at Southeast Georgia Health System. Impressed by the area's beauty and southern hospitality, and the hospital's dedicated staff and physicians, he returned to the area after medical school.
