Houston County Habitat for Humanity is part of a global, nonprofit housing organization operated on Christian principles that seeks to put God's love into action by building homes,

communities and hope here in Houston County and around the world. As a title partner to Habitat for Humanity International, we are allowed the opportunity to help build Habitat homes in several poor countries. To date, Houston County Habitat for Humanity has built 42 homes overseas and tithed over \$100,000 dollars from our unrestricted funds towards helping needy families in less fortunate countries realize the dream of homeownership.

Houston County Habitat for Humanity has built 76 new homes and completed over 500 repairs locally. Habitat homeowners provide 200-300 hours of sweat equity, a \$1000 down payment, and are issued an affordable 0% interest loan that ensures a brighter future for themselves and their families.
