Phoebe Wound Care & Hyperbaric Medicine utilizes the region's largest hyperbaric chamber, a spacious multi-place chamber that accommodates up to 12 people and minimizes the claustrophobic effects of a single patient chamber. Hyperbaric oxygen therapy involves breathing pure oxygen in a pressurized environment. It is used to treat serious infections and injuries, wounds that may not heal because of diabetes or other conditions, and decompression sickness.
