She also worked with Five Points Psychiatry, Five Points Eye Care, and Dr. Alan Glassman, pediatrician, in Athens throughout her journey in medicine. In addition, she has experience as a first grade teacher with Campus Clubs, a community development center in Macon that focuses on inner-city children and families, and as a special needs caregiver for an Autistic adolescent in Athens.

"It's a very full circle moment to join a healthcare system I was literally born into," she said. "My mentor, Dr. Billie Jackson, inspired me to approach every patient by addressing the 'whole body' – the physical, mental, emotional, and social components of health. And my faith has always been an important part of me, my values, and my outlook towards patient care."
